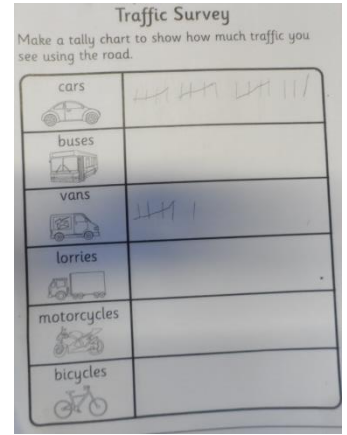
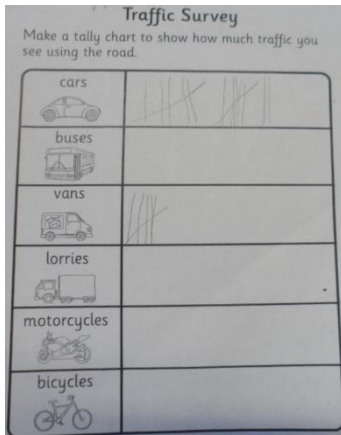


Year 2 Learning Celebration

We have learnt about the similarities and differences between villages, towns and cities. We enjoyed looking at a variety of maps and creating our own map of our walk to school.



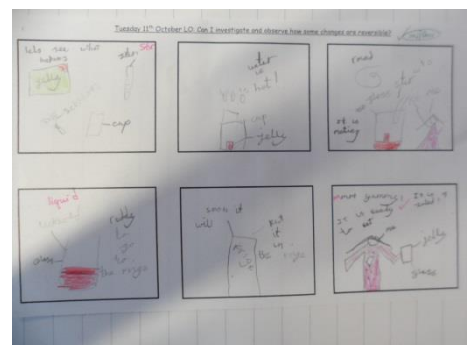
Values Week
