### Our topic in Term 2 will be 'Traditional Tales'

This topic will allow us to find out more about the children and their favourite fairy tales. We will be looking at different traditional tales, such as Goldilocks and The Three Bears, Three Little Pigs and Polar Express. In English work we will continue to work on key reading and writing skills such as linking letters to sounds and forming letter shapes. In Maths we will be using numbers to 20 (and sometimes beyond) to solve practical problems. Also looking at number formation and the ordering of numbers and directions.

We will be reading regularly with your child, please let us know how they get on with the book they are given.

### Ways to help your child

**Keep in touch** - read and sign the contact book every day.


**Read** - try to share a book with your child at least 3 times a week.
