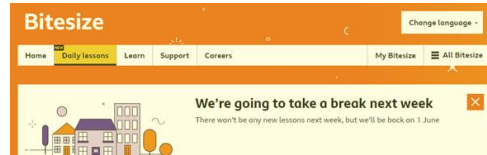

Maths + On-Line Learning

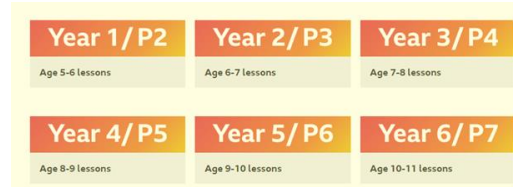
