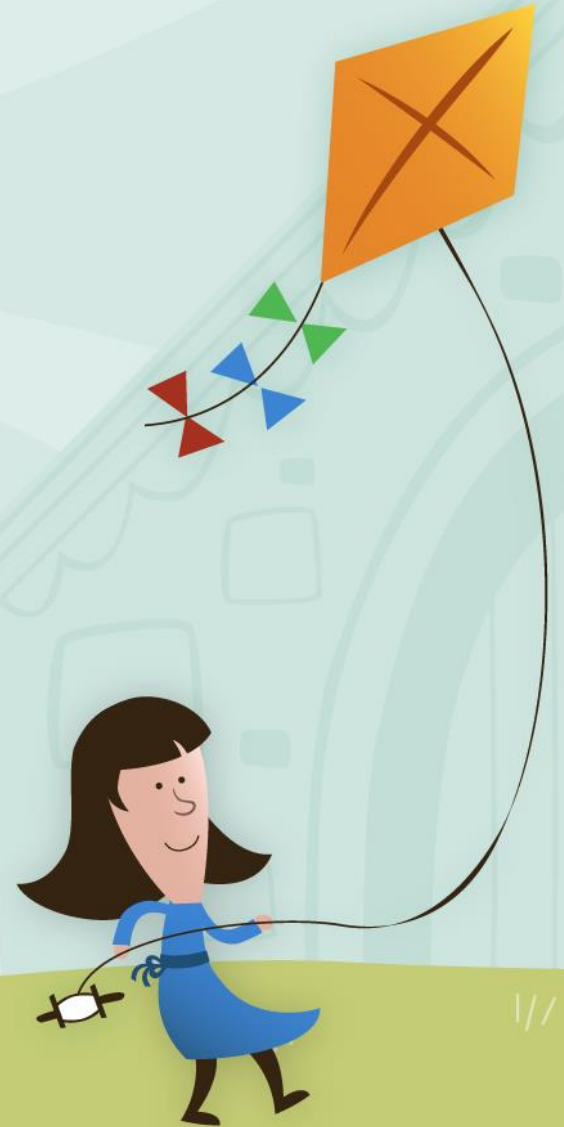

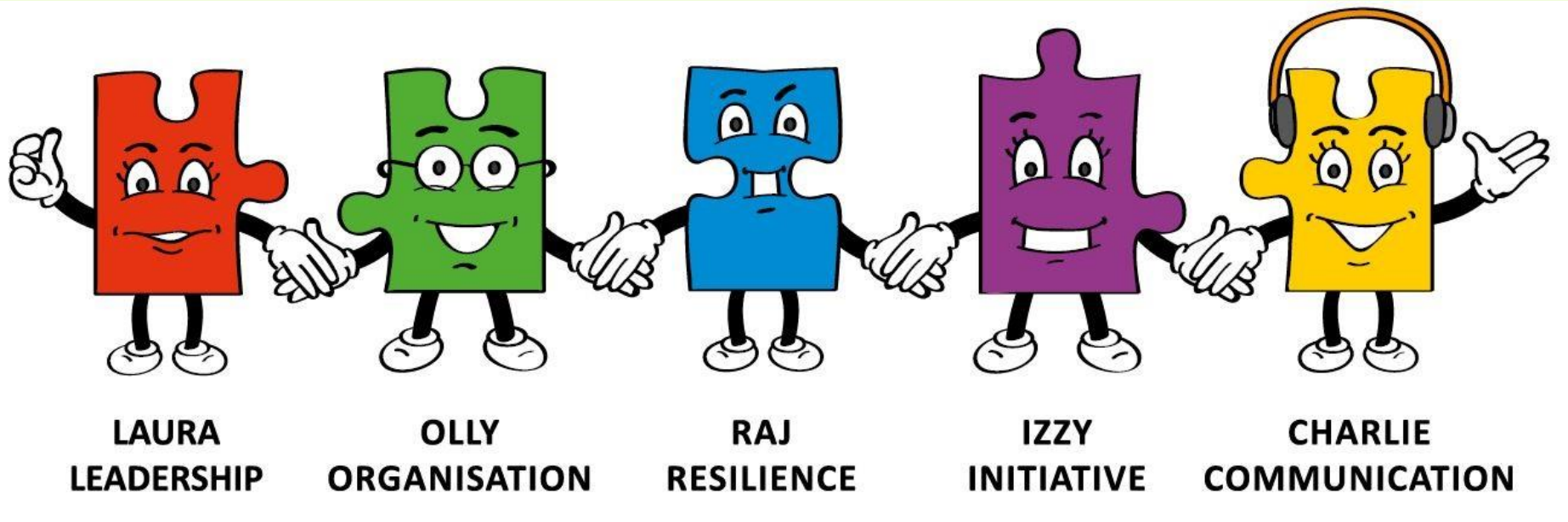
Learning
