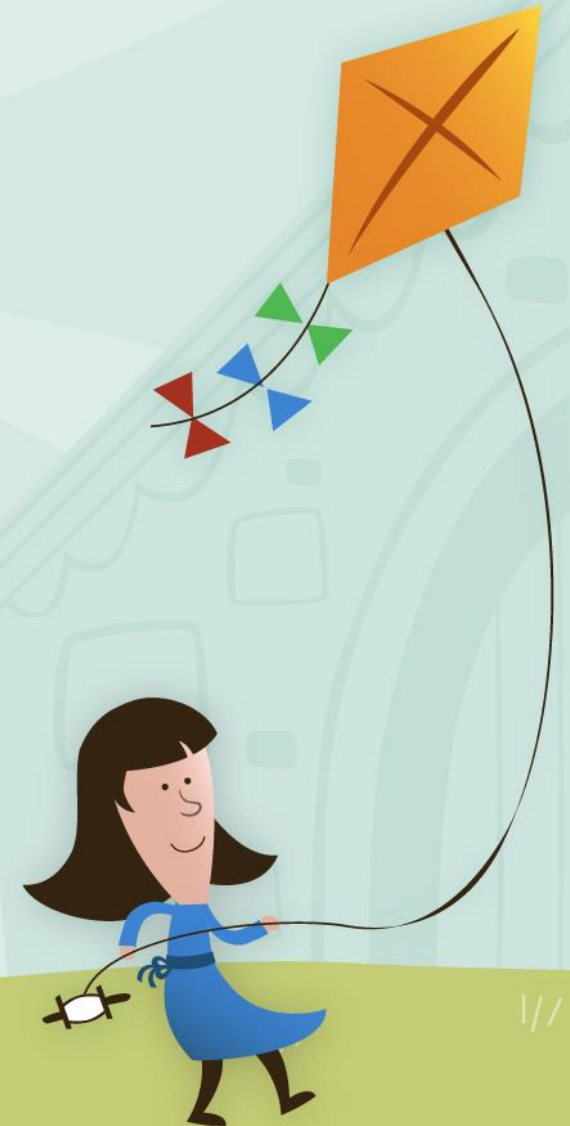

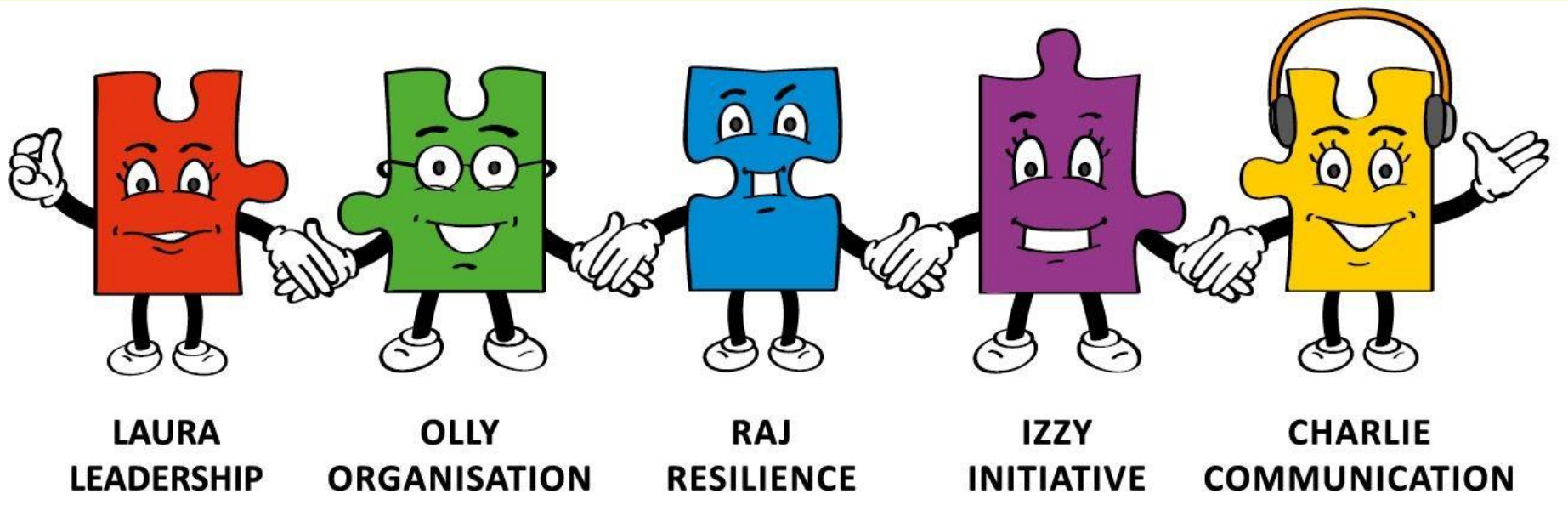
# Systems in place
