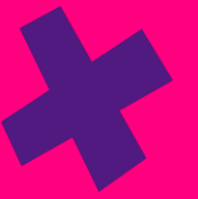

WHAT IS THE MTC?



- MTC stands for 'Multiplication Tables Check'.
- Online quiz for year 4 children in England, set by the government.
- Pupils demonstrate their times tables skills, which they've been practising for years.
- Helps us to know your children are ready for maths in year 5 and beyond.



MTC KEY FACTS



- Must be taken in school between 1st and 12th June 2026
 - Start with 3 practice questions
 - Then 25 multiplication questions (no division)
 - For each question, you must enter an answer within 6s
 - 3s pause between questions
- 

MTC RESULTS



- Full marks is 25/25 but there's no pass mark.
- An average will be taken nationally and shared.
- Each school finds out the Local Authority and National average but not each other's results.
- The results will be shared with parents as part of the child's end of year school report.

PREPARING PUPILS : SCHOOL

PREPARING PUPILS : OUT OF SCHOOL



- Regular, *short* verbal times tables practice at any given opportunity

- Use of:

- youtube songs

- Flashcards (should you require electronic copies, please ask)

- topmark maths



- hit the button. [Hit the Button - Quick fire maths practise for 6-11 year olds](#)

- Play TTRS on mobile/tablet/computer

- Those who scored **25** last year typically played **6 minutes three times a week.**

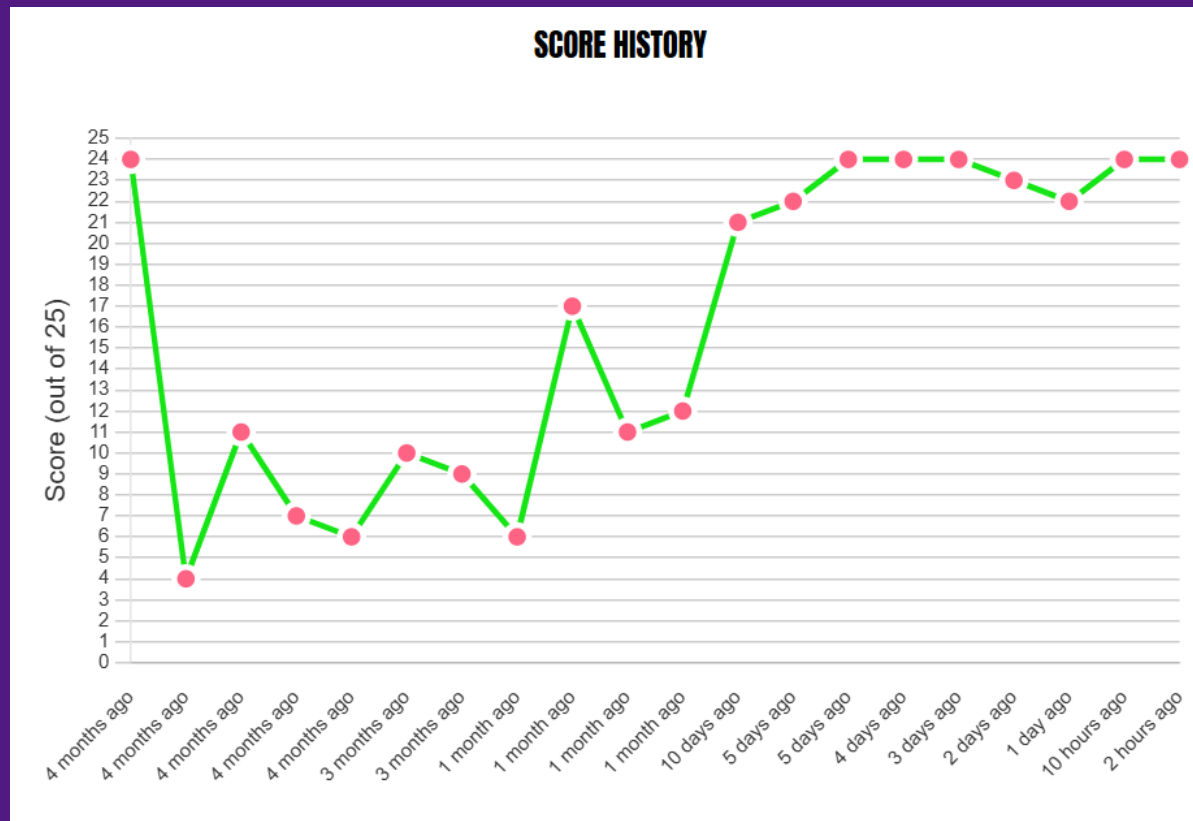
CASE STUDY OF CHILD CURRENTLY IN HSW YEAR 4 COHORT

- Their score has significantly improved from **10** only a month ago to **24** this week!

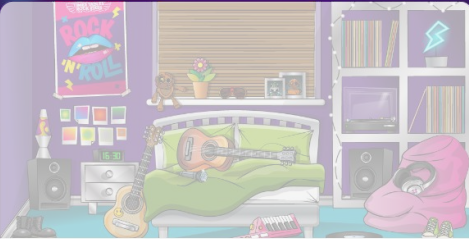

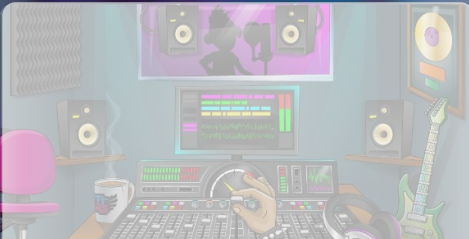

NATIONAL VS OUR DATA



- Last year, 37% of the national year 4 cohort scored full marks (25).
- 40% of our current year 4 cohort scored full mark on their last soundcheck.



- Last year, the national average was 21 out of 25.
- Our current year 4 cohort are scoring 19.5.
