

Last term in Year 4:

Last term, Year 4 explored a fantastic unit on the Digestive System. They learned about the key organs involved, how each one functions, and the journey food takes through the human body. To deepen their understanding, pupils took part in a range of practical investigations and modelling activities, including creating salt dough teeth, observing the reaction between sugar and yeast, using plaque-revealing tablets to support teeth brushing, modelling the digestive system, carrying out an egg-enamel experiment and designing digestive system T shirts.
