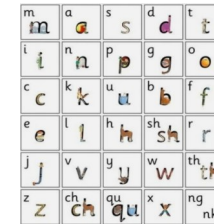
Term Focus–

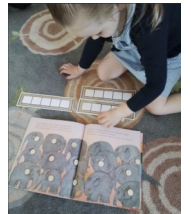
Phonics (Read Write Inc)
